



1. Fines for books, magazines, and audiovisual materials:

- Books, magazines, audio books, audio cassette tapes, computer software, and musical compact discs are due on date stamped. These items may be renewed one time. Fines are ten cents per day.
- **Video tapes and DVDs can be checked out for seven days with no renewals.** Fines for video tapes and DVDs are fifty cents per day per item.
- **The threshold for all library fines is set at \$3.00.** At this point patrons are asked to pay their fines before checking out more library materials or using the Internet.

2. Fees:

▶ **Copier and printer usage: 25 cents per page**

▶ **Color copies from color printer: \$1.00 per page**

▶ **Lost or damaged library materials:**

- Each lost item is assessed according to its value in the library collection.
- A patron may replace a lost or damaged item with an identical copy or item of similar cost.
